Current crop failure / famine projections from 63 (as of September) eruptions for the summer of 2013 are extremely disturbing

2012 U.S. crop failure marks the worst famine in the history of the U.S. Agriculture and the volcanic eruption fallout continued through the spring and summer of 2012. A full one year ahead of peak damage

Note to Quakes: April 12, 2012 8.6 Richter Scale Indonesian Slip-Slid quake was 200 times stronger than most seismologist thought was possible. But beside that anomaly, 2012 quakes don't seem to be on the rise, just closer monitoring.
