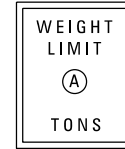

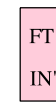
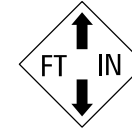
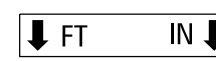
POSTED BRIDGE ON STATE ROUTE
